This product is acceptable for use as a solvent for cleaning electronic instruments and devices (K2), which will not tolerate aqueous cleaning solutions in and around food processing areas, where its use is not intended for direct food contact. Before using this compound, food products and packaging materials must be removed from the area or carefully protected. This compound must be used in a manner so that all odors associated with the compound are dissipated before food products or packaging materials are re-exposed in the area.
